

## The Shed Cookbook is Nearing Completion

**The Real Men's Cookbook**

**THAI FISH CAKES**

Makes 18 cakes about 65g each

800g boneless white fish fillets  
1/4 cup chopped fresh coriander  
2 egg whites  
1/4 cup Red Curry paste  
1t chopped red chilli  
zest of 1 lime  
1t sugar

3 finely sliced shallots  
80g finely sliced green beans  
3/4 - 1 cup plain flour

Accompany with Sweet Thai Dressing and rocket salad

**Method:**

Process fish, coriander, egg whites, curry paste, chilli, lime zest and sugar in food processor until smooth.

Stir in shallots and beans.

Mould heaped tablespoons of mixture with wet hands into patties and roll lightly in a tray of plain flour. Dust off excess flour.

Heat oil in frypan and place patties carefully into hot oil to fry on each side for 3 minutes until golden brown.

Drain on kitchen towel.


**To serve - accompany with SWEET THAI DRESSING:**



1/2 cup white vinegar  
1/2 cup castor sugar  
2T lime juice  
1T fish sauce  
1/2 red capsicum finely chopped  
2T chopped coriander

**Method:**

Combine vinegar, sugar and juice in a small saucepan and stir over heat until sugar is dissolved. Do not boil rapidly but simmer very gently for 3 mins then cool.

Stir in remaining ingredients.
