We have been notified by the Ku-ring-gai Council that we were successful with our grant applications.

- \$ 3,000 for our Cooking Class activity.
- \$ 1,944 for new Computers and a wireless microphone system (great addition in time for the AGM!)

A very special thanks must go to Kevin who again expertly submitted the applications. A great outcome.

The Ku-ring-gai Council has distributed nearly \$50,000 over 16 grants for environmental projects to community groups and individuals.

The Community Shed at St Ives received \$3,180 to create crafted hollows for breeding wildlife.

Mayor Jennifer Anderson said the number of applications reflected the popularity of the grants scheme.
