We are pleased to advise that The Shed will reopen on the 18th October to all members.

We are looking forward to catching up and enjoying your company.

The period from 11th-15th October is dedicated to a **Clean Up and Clean Out** program with no personal activities being undertaken.

The committee, coordinators and some of their team members are putting in a terrific effort to prepare our Shed for the reopening and to undertake the infrastructure and maintenance activities planned.

We really need as much help as we can to make our Shed a place to be really proud of.

Your committee and coordinators have been very active during lockdown organising our activities going forward despite not being able to attend The Shed or meet.

We will have some great new things for you.

- The router table is being upgraded to allow height adjustment and insertion of router bits above the table.
- Mark Champion and his team are installing high volume air extraction systems in the wood workshop area and a fume extraction system in the welding area. These were funded by grants.
- A new dust extraction system is being deployed for the wood turning area.
- The Shed will be very clean with our air quality being well managed and monitored.
- The milling machine is being upgraded with a new lubrication system and a new set of bits (very sharp).
- The sanding machines will be in a great state that we really wish to maintain through careful and proper use.
- The Tormek burnishing system is being refurbished.
- The security systems have been upgraded to provide online notifications and access.
- The area around The Shed has been planted out with native plants and covered with mulch.

We will have very specific requirements to ensure the health of our members.

Members Must:

- Be double vaccinated and provide proof of vaccination.
- Pre-book attendance through the Eventbrite system. You will be asked to confirm your vaccination status when registering.
- Sign in using the Service NSW QR code app. The QR codes are posted at all of the entry doors.
- Wear a mask inside
- Observe the maximum number of people directions posted in each area
- Observe social distancing of 1.5 meters depending on NSW Health Regulations in force

Proof of vaccination

This can be provided by:

- Emailing your certificated direct from Medicare to kushed@bigpond.com
- Showing proof of vaccination in your QR code app when that capability is deployed

• Showing your certificate or an image thereof to the coordinator when you attend.

You will then be issued with a sticker for your name badge and you will not be required to provide proof again.
